Matters arising from minutes:
a. Waste bins - installed at no cost

Council of the Year for 2013. Thanks were expressed to all who have supported the Parish meeting.
6. Any other business:
i. As of yet there is no confirmed date for the Village Hall broad band connection.
ii. Dog fouling is a continuing problem around the village.
iii. Village Hall guttering is not attached properly Ken Sutherland offered to repair.
iv. There is a large amount of water still flowing off the fields and the drains on the road opposite the village hall not coping with volume. To look into possible blockage.
v. Roger Patterson advised meeting that further consultation will take place concerning the development of a future Core Strategy.
vi. Roger Patterson is supporting the proposal to redirect the ScunthorpeLincoln bus route into both the villages of Glentworth and Fillingham.
